Following much discussion, the following changes to goals were determined:

Beginning at Section 4.3

Goal 1: Objective B add “and its impacts on residents and property owners.”

Goal 7: Objective B add “encourage the county to do the same”.

Goal 8: Objective A add “assisted living facilities”; Objective B change word monitor to support; Add an Objective D that says “where there is opportunity to coordinate with the county regarding quality health, child care and assisted living facilities”.

Goal 9: Objective A add “Ensure the county provides adequate level of”; Add an Objective E “support the enhanced use of technology for public safety”.

Goal 10: Objective B add “Madison” to University of Wisconsin Extension.

Section 5.2

Agricultural Resources

Goal 1: after much discussion strike objective C fully; Objective E add “and use of natural resources”; Objective F change word promote to support; Objective G “and carbon footprint and protect air quality”; Objective H strike younger farmers and add “new and next generation farmers”; Objective I add the word “existing” to agricultural history. Objective J change the word Increase and replace it with “Foster” also take out “noises and odors”
Goal 2: Objective A strike the words “and to allow for farming expansion”; Objective C add “buffers and setbacks” and residential home instead of residential neighborhoods. Add a goal E and F and G from county plan page 37.

Goal 1: Objective B checking with Dave Ferris at county Objective D add physical access to the lakes and rivers.

Goal 3: Objective D change the words “carefully manage” to “make recommendations to county for”

Goal 4: Objective B remove word “regulated”

Goal 5: Objective A and B plus Add all of what county has on theirs by changing county to town.

Goal 6: Add the word “recreational” to the list in the goal itself.
